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GREENBELT RESOURCES GAINS AFP PERMIT APPROVAL, ANNOUNCES PLANT READINESS FOR FEEDSTOCK PROCESSING PILOT STUDIES

BURNSVILLE, Minn., June 10, 2010 – Greenbelt Resources Corporation (Pink Sheets: GRCO) today announced the approval of its alcohol fuel plant (AFP) permit by the Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau. The permit enables the Diversified feedstock-to-ethanol processing plant, located in Paso Robles, California, to begin conducting pilot studies for clients.

Pilot study services will help producers of food and beverage wastes as well as generators of cellulosic and vegetation-based waste to determine the costs and yield data necessary to validate their feedstock as a viable source for ethanol. Feasibility studies on proven feedstocks can then be conducted to inform a plant design. The company currently offers phase one and phase two feasibility studies on proven feedstocks.

The Diversified pilot plant has a capacity of 70,000 proof gallons per year. Diversified designs plants with capacities ranging from 50,000 to five million gallons per year. Pilot studies on cellulosic feedstocks such as [switchgrass as well as starch-rich grains and fruits and vegetables](#) will in part provide information needed to scale-up processing capacity. A pilot plant study offers clients a higher degree of validation of the business viability for their feedstock prior to constructing a localized processing plant.

Greenbelt Resources also intends to utilize the Diversified plant to conduct experiments and testing on proven feedstocks to determine opportunities for increased efficiencies in converting wastes to ethanol.



Pilot study services will begin in Q3 2010 starting at a base fee range of \$10,000 to \$40,000 depending on the complexity and amount of sample feedstock available for the pilot. Additional information about the pilot plant can read on the [Diversified website](#).
